Biu Jee. Biu Gee is the third and final hand form of the Wing Chun system and is generally only taught to trusted Wing Chun practitioners. Biu Gee contains advanced techniques and emergency escapes. Bul Gee teaches how to perfect the use of 'inch energy', enabling the practitioner to develop power through very short distances.

Wing Chun Biu Jee Thrusting Fingers (Bil Jee) : WingChun  
Biu Gee (thrusting/darting fingers) is sometimes also referred to as Biu Tse, Biu Jee or even Bil Gee. The form has a number of parts which don't break down into 3 sections quite as easily as Sil Lim Tao. Other emergency techniques are seen in Biu Gee, for example the use of Biu Gee/Tse to escape when the elbow has been pinned.

Wing Chun Biu Jee | Udemy  
Biu Jee. Biu jee (darting fingers) or "standard compass" concentrates on cutting back to centerline, just as the hand on a compass returns to pointing north. Biu Jee is sometimes said to contain emergency techniques that can be used to recover from a loss of centerline. This is the most advanced empty hand form in Ving Tsun...

Biu Jee | Wing Chun Kung Fu  
Biu Gee (thrusting/darting fingers) is sometimes also referred to as Biu Tse, Biu Jee or even Bil Gee. The different ways to spell it, arise because it is hard to Romanise (put into Latin or western letters) Cantonese speech.

In this movement both hands form a prayer and dip down; as the hands press upward the body rises.

Wing Chun: The Secret Techniques of Biu Jee  
Biu Ji (Thrusting Fingers) The third form, and the last form Biu Ji, is composed of extreme short-range and extreme long-range techniques, low kicks and sweeps, and "emergency techniques" to counter-attack when structure and centerline have been seriously compromised, such as when the practitioner is seriously injured.

Moy Yat - Biu Je  
Biu Jee is the final empty hand form taught in Wing Chun. Traditionally it was only taught to the most trusted students because the techniques taught at this level were so deadly that the master could not afford to have rival schools knowing about them.

Wing Chun Biu Gee Syllabus - Putney Martial Arts  
Biu Jee is Sifu Gary Lam's entry for the third and final open-hand form of Wing Chun. This form is also known as the "Emergency Form." Once again the late Wong Shun Leung's experience with challenge fights (Beimo) can be seen within the form.

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
