Differential Diagnosis 3 : Pancreatitis (The Awkward Yeti [theawkwardyeti], 2012) Pancreatitis: Pancreatitis is an obstructive disease that occurs when the outflow of digestive enzymes are blocked. This obstruction results in the release of enzymes which cause auto digestion of cells and tissues.

Acute Pancreatitis • Reversible inflammation of the pancreas • Ranges between mild, moderate, and severe • Attacks can be once or recurring • Prognosis o Differs depending on severity o Organ failure within 24 hours of admit significantly increases risk of death (1) • Morbidity o 210, 000 hospitalized/year for acute pancreatitis (1)

### Differential Diagnoses | Pancreatitis Case Study

The causes of acute pancreatitis are extensive and include structural, metabolic and toxic aetiologies (table 1). In this case, cholelithiasis or other obstructive causes were ruled out by the imaging studies performed and her history was not forthcoming for toxin exposure or alcohol ingestion, infections, trauma or drug induced.

CASE STUDY Acute Pancreatitis | Gallbladder | Pancreas

Pancreatitis, which is the inflammation of the pancreas, can be acute or chronic in nature. It may be caused by edema, necrosis or hemorrhage. In men, this disease is commonly associated to alcoholism, peptic ulcer or trauma; in women, it's associated to biliary tract disease. Prognosis is usually good when pancreatitis follows biliary tract disease, but poor when the factor is alcoholism.
