The legislatures of 2/3rds of the states may require Congress to summon a constitutional convention to consider amendments. What are the two ways of ratifying the amendments? An amendment is official when 3/4ths of state legislatures approve it. When special conventions in 3/4ths of the states approve it.

An amendment to the Constitution is a change that can add to the Constitution or change an older part of it. An amendment can even overturn a previous amendment, as the 21st did to the 18th. There are a few methods to amend the Constitution, but the most common is to pass an amendment through the Congress, on a two-thirds vote.
