The cervix or cervix uteri (Latin, 'neck of the uterus') is the lower part of the uterus in the human female reproductive system.The cervix is usually 2 to 3 cm long (~1 inch) and roughly cylindrical in shape, which changes during pregnancy.The narrow, central cervical canal runs along its entire length, connecting the uterine cavity and the lumen of the vagina.
