Food habits of marten in the Pacific states may be more diverse than elsewhere (Zielinski and others 1983; Martin 1994; Bull 2000). For example, in the east-central Cascade Range, Washington, arthropods (bees, ants, wasps, and beetles) occurred most often in marten scats (Newby 1951), whereas in north-eastern Oregon, vole-sized mammals dominated (Bull 2000).

Small amounts of dairy and fish may be consumed daily,...

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Food Habits Of The Paci  
Fruits, fruit juices, vegetables, and nuts (e.g., peanuts, macadamia, and litchi) are eaten in abundance, while milk and other dairy products are uncommon (there is a high prevalence of lactose intolerance. among Pacific Islanders). Coconuts are plentiful, and both the milk and dried fruit are used to flavor meals.
