The Royal Arch Degrees was considered so important in the early years of Freemasonry that at the formation of the United Grand Lodge of England in 1813, when the then two Grand Lodges in England, the Antients and the Moderns, united to form a single Grand Lodge, a firm and solemn landmark was adopted and placed in the Articles of Union to guide Masons throughout the world forever on this matter.

The Royal Arch is present in all main masonic systems, though in some it is worked as part of Craft ('mainstream') Freemasonry, and in others in an appendant ('additional') order. Royal Arch Masons meet as a Chapter; in the Supreme Order of the Holy Royal Arch as practised in the British Isles, much of Europe and the Commonwealth, Chapters confer ...

Books for Masonic Body - Royal Arch Masons

This was neatly done within an extension to the degree later called the Holy Royal Arch. For Dermott it was 'the root, heart and marrow of Masonry' so several lodges today still work both elements sequentially. Records of the award of this Royal Arch degree occur from 1740 onwards.' 'Modern Grand Lodge still wouldn't buy it.
