### ~~How to Cite a Textbook in a Syllabus | Pen and the Pad~~

To cite a book in MLA style (8th edition), the Works Cited list entry must always identify the author(s), title, publisher and publication date of the work. If available, include the names of any editors or translators, the edition, and the volume. If you accessed the book online, add the name of the website or database and the URL.

### ~~3 Ways to Cite a Textbook — wikiHow~~

When you are using a textbook as a source in your References list, you cite it the same way you would cite any other book. Type the first author's name. You type her last name first, followed by a comma, followed by her initials.

Similar to formatting a citation for the reference page, we need to take into

consideration how to use in-text citations if the textbook has multiple authors or no author.

## ~~Citing Electronic or Online Books—APA Citation Style ...~~

APA Chapter or Authored Section of an Edited Book Citation. Examples are not double-spaced, but your References list should be double-spaced; Examples do not show indented lines after the first line, but yours should be indented

## ~~How to Cite a Textbook in APA Format—Video & Lesson ...~~

When you are citing to a work that has been published by the same publisher more than once, you should cite the edition and the year it was published in the parentheses. Example: Lawrence Lessig, Code: Version 2.0 (2nd ed. 2006) If the edition is from a different publisher than the original, you should note the publisher.

The first line of each reference should be flush left with the margin of the page. Each subsequent line of your reference should be indented. If a digital object identifier (DOI) is available, include it at the end of the reference. If a book has been accessed via an online database, follow the basic APA format and include the URL at the end.

As a teacher, you might want to cite the course textbook in the syllabus for two reasons -- to ensure students know exactly which book to buy, and to provide a specific example of a citation students would write in an essay or paper for the class. Use the style format you expect your students to use in their papers.

## ~~The Right Way to List Book References in APA Format~~

If the pamphlet you are citing has no author, cite as directed below. If your pamphlet has an author or a corporate author, put the name of the author (last name, first name format) or corporate author in the place where the author name typically appears at the beginning of the entry. (See also Books by a Corporate Author or Organization above.)

How to Cite a Textbook - Using APA Style  
Start with the last name of the author or editor. Add the year of publication in parentheses. Provide the title of the textbook. Close your citation with the name and location of the publisher. Include information to specify a chapter.

In a reference to a whole book, cite the edition and volume numbers—separated by a comma—but do not cite a page range. Here are some templates for citing print versions of books that include edition and volume numbers:
