UNIT 3 Macroeconomics OVERVIEW

Figure 3-2.4 shows the relationship between a firm's MC and AVC: $AVC = TVC/Q$. If the firm has L as its only variable resource, then AVC represents the labor cost per unit of output. Suppose a firm pays each of its 10 workers a daily wage of \$80 and produces a Q of 400 units. Its TVC is $\$800 = (10)(\$80)$, and its AVC is $\$2 = \$800/400$.
