nonspecific: responds within minutes to protect body from foreign substances; 1st line of defense = external body membranes like intact skin and mucosa, 2nd line of defense = called into action when 1st line of defense has been penetrated; relies on internal defenses such as antimicrobial proteins, phagocytes, and other cells that inhibit the spread of foreign bodies (hallmark is inflammation ...
