**SUBJECT: New ATC Phraseology for Runway Construction** **BACKGROUND:** Effective Sep 22, 2011, ATC will begin using new phraseology during periods of runway construction. Runway construction activities result in changes to the runway environment and performance considerations, potentially increasing risk if the changes are not effectively communicated.

For those who are new to this phrase, here is a basic primer on this new phraseology: **Current Phraseology:** "Taxi into Position" or "Taxi to Position and Wait" **New Phraseology:** "Line Up" or "Line Up and Wait" **Definition:** Used by ATC to inform a pilot to taxi onto the departure runway in takeoff position and wait (hold).
